*Francis Bacon*



As 2023 enters its final month we have been reflecting on some of the Francis Bacon related events and activities the year has brought us. These have included the release of the inaugural **Bacon Review** alongside many exhibitions that have celebrated his work, including the Bown and Bacon display at the Hugh Lane Gallery, Tate Modern's 'Capturing the Moment' and the Kallman Museum's 'Images of Man – The Klewan Collection' in Germany.

There is also the "**Endless Variations**" exhibition currently showing at the Ordovas gallery. This is the first exhibition dedicated to Francis Bacon and Andy Warhol, exploring their shared interests and influences. These included their use of colour, photography and image serialisation. The showcase features rarely-seen paintings, photos, archival material and an essay by Martin Harrison.

The Burlington Magazine published an **article** in September that examined Francis Bacon's relationship with Denis Wirth Miller. Katharina Günther explored how the two artists were introduced to each-other by mutual friends and how they would go on to forge a strong bond over years spent working together.

We also collaborated with the **ars publicata** team to enhance their presentation of Francis Bacon's graphic works on their new website. We support all efforts to improve access to and the accuracy of information about Bacon and his artworks, as we work to preserve his legacy.
