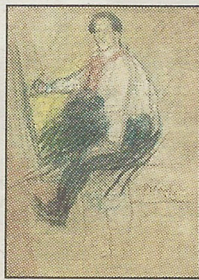

## Picasso selfie on show in London for the first time

A SKETCH by Pablo Picasso is on public display for the first time today.

The study was the artist's preliminary sketch for a famous self-portrait – Yo Picasso.

It is at the Ordovas Gallery in Savile Row as part of an exhibition tracing the development of the self-portrait. Called *Self*, the exhibition will also feature portraits by Damien Hirst and Jeff Koons and one of the first studies of a single head by Francis Bacon, which has not been shown in London for almost 50 years.

The Picasso study, created with charcoal and pastels, is from a private collector and has never been shown before.
